2nd Reading

Change list into bullets and capitalize first letter in each bullet

Last paragraph, 2nd line, delete “during the school year”

1st paragraph, change “operation of the pool” to “pool operation”

2nd paragraph, change “supervisor” to “supervisor’s”

Remove lifeguard and pool manuals from policy EBBC and they will be maintained by the Activities Director
