The Medford Area Public School District Board of Education derives its authority to govern and act as a policy making body from the Constitution and statutes of the State of Wisconsin. The board of education recognizes that by custom and tradition it has a responsibility to the citizenry it serves and the persons it employs, to discharge its duties and obligations in a manner that will ensure the highest possible educational level for the citizens of the Medford Area Public School District.

Number of Board Members

The board of education will consist of nine members, elected at large by a plurality vote cast by the qualified electors of the school district.

Term of Office

Board of education members shall serve three years except as otherwise provided by law.
