Medford Area Public School District Board of Education (BOE) derives its authority to govern and act as a policy making body from the Constitution and statutes of the State of Wisconsin. The BOE recognizes that by custom and tradition it has a responsibility to the citizenry it serves and the persons it employs, to discharge its duties and obligations in a manner that will ensure the highest possible educational level for the citizens of MAPSD.

Qualifications

Any eligible elector may be a candidate for BOE membership. An eligible elector must be a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age and a resident of the district for at least 28 days preceding the election.

Number of Board Members

The BOE will consist of nine members, elected at large by a plurality vote cast by the qualified electors of the school district.

Term of Office

BOE members shall serve three years except as otherwise provided by law.
