The Medford Area Public School District Board of Education has complete and final control over local school matters subject to limitations and requirements imposed by state and federal regulations. The board of education may do all things reasonable to promote the cause of education, including establishing, providing, and improving district programs, functions, and activities for the benefit of students.

Although the board of education retains full legislative and judicial authority over the schools, it delegates all executive, supervisory, and instructional authority and operation to its professional staff under the direction of the district administrator.
