The Medford Area Public School District Board of Education is composed of nine citizens of the district who are elected at large by the qualified voters at the annual spring election.

Members of the board of education serve overlapping terms of three years except as otherwise provided by law and take office on the fourth Monday in April. At the end of the term, a board of education member wishing to continue his/her service to the community must be re-elected to an additional three-year term. State law does not limit the number of terms a member may serve.

The school district clerk is responsible for overseeing the legality and orderliness of school board elections. The clerk shall follow all procedures as provided by law.

Dates for various election notices and activities are specified in state law and will be complied with by the district.
