Medford Area Public School District Board of Education (BOE) may meet in closed session only to discuss subject matter within the scope of state statutes. No discussions of any matter shall be held and no action taken of any kind, formal or informal, by the BOE while in closed session, except as specifically authorized by law.

Before the BOE convenes in closed session, a majority vote of the BOE members present shall be required and the BOE president shall announce to those present the nature of the business to be considered at the closed session and the specific exemption(s) under law by which the session is authorized. The BOE shall take a roll call vote to convene in closed session.

Public notice shall be given of all closed sessions in accordance with state law and BOE policy.
