No food or beverage machines other than as outlined below are permitted in school buildings without approval of the school board. Requests and approval for vending machines in staff lounges or work areas must be made to the building principal who will submit them to the district administrator. The board may approve vending machines to dispense food or beverages to students in the Medford Area Senior High School. All vending machine sales and receipts must be accounted for in accordance with board policy and accepted accounting and audit standards. The building principal is responsible for the operation of vending machines in his/her building.

The Medford Area Public School District may participate in federally subsidized food and nutrition programs. At such times as the Medford Area Public School District is participating in a federally subsidized food and nutrition program, the sale of foods with minimal nutritional value shall be prohibited in food service areas during meal periods. Foods of minimal nutritional value include soft drinks, icees, chewing gum, and certain types of candies (hard candies, jellies, and gums, marshmallow candies, fondant, licorice, spun candy, and candy-coated popcorn). This prohibition applies to all food sales in the food service areas, including sales from vending machines.
