Attendance for students in the Medford Area Public Schools District will be based on 180 days with a maximum of five (5) days to be used for inclement weather and parent-teacher conferences. A regular school day shall be defined as six and one-half (6 ½) hours per day for grades K – 12.

Any student enrolled in four (4) or more full-time equivalency class periods will be considered a full-time student. Students must enroll on a full-time basis as defined above with the exception of students enrolled for the ninth semester of high school.

Students who are enrolled by the Medford Area Public School District in full or part-time programs outside their school building, or the district facilities, in order to meet work study and/or specifications of a specially designed or alternative program will be considered a full-time student. A resident student attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law shall be considered full-time in their district of residence.

Variation of the above may be made by the district administrator when extenuating circumstances make it necessary.
