Attendance for students in the Medford Area Public Schools District (MAPSD) will be based on meeting DPI requirements for the number of minutes.

SES – 7 hours, 12 minutes MAES – 7 hours, 19 minutes MAMS – 7 hours, 24 minutes MASH – 7 hours, 28 minutes

Any student enrolled in four or more full-time equivalency class periods will be considered a full-time student. Students must enroll on a full-time basis with the exception of students enrolled for the ninth semester of high school.

Students who are enrolled in MAPSD full or part-time programs outside their school building, or district facilities, in order to meet work study and/or specifications of a specially designed or alternative program, will be considered full-time students. A resident student attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law shall be considered full-time in their district of residence.

Variation of the above may be made by the district administrator under extenuating circumstances.
