Medford Area Public School District Board of Education (BOE) shall, upon recommendation of the district administrator or their designee, consider and adopt or reject new programs and courses when they constitute an addition or a significant alteration in instructional content or approach.

The district administrator or their designee shall be responsible for implementing the courses of instruction and shall keep the BOE informed of the district's programs and compliance with state law.
