Medford Area Public School District (MAPSD) Board of Education policy is, pursuant to state and federal laws, that no person, on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability, may be denied admission to any school in MAPSD or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of or be discriminated against in any co-curricular, student services, recreational or other program.

In accordance with state law, MAPSD shall make available to any school age parent in the district, program modifications and services that will enable the student to continue their education. "School age parent" includes any person under the age of 21 who is not a high school graduate and is a parent, an expectant parent or a person who has been pregnant within the preceding 120 days.

Pregnancy, marital or parental status shall not affect the rights and privileges of students to receive a public education or participate in student activities and programs.
