Rural Virtual Academy (RVA) shall operate, when feasible, summer sessions for high school students who desire developmental, tutorial, or enrichment instruction. RVA students in grades PreK–7 have access to additional programming during summer months as part of their year-round schooling and therefore, do not need to enroll in a summer school program.

All RVA students electing to take summer school courses for high school credit advancement may take a maximum of one credit, requiring no less than 8,100 instructional minutes. Students who are deemed to be credit deficient are allowed to exceed the maximum number of credits in any given year per RVA administrator or their designee's prior approval.

When offered, RVA students who have successfully completed grade 8 may elect to take basic technology and study skills course, level 1 physical education and/or health and wellness course.

RVA students have access to summer school programming only after having been enrolled in RVA for all or part of one semester.

Summer school attendance policies, necessary tuition and/or fees and other basic operational procedures shall be established by an RVA administrator or designee.

RVA high school students will be provided all necessary technology and materials needed to complete summer school requirements. RVA is not responsible for summer school transportation.
