In accordance with Wisconsin Statute 120.12(3) it is resolved that the Board of Education of the School District of Medford adopt a tax levy for the 2022-23 year in the amount of \$5,947,659 which calls for an estimated all fund tax levy mill rate of 5.42 mills (\$5.42 per \$1000 of equalized property value). [Understanding that "on or before, November 1 the school board shall determine the amount necessary to be raised to operate and maintain the schools of the school district if the annual meeting has not voted a tax sufficient for such purposes for the school year. "Wisconsin Statute 120.12(3) (a)]. A motion is needed to adopt a tax levy for the 2022-2023 school year in the amount of \$5,947,659 which calls for an estimated tax levy mill rate of 5.42 mills.
