EDF – Waste Management
3rd bullet, 1st line, delete “being” and “the”, 2nd line, delete “the” and “of” and last line, delete a section of sentence.
4th bullet, last line, end sentence after “available”

EEA – Student Transportation Services
Page 1, 3rd paragraph, delete last sentence
5th paragraph, 1st line, delete “The”, replace “responsibilities” with “Responsibility, 2nd line, delete “subsequently”
Page 2, 3rd paragraph, delete “the”

JHCA – Control of Pediculosis (Lice)
Page 1, 3rd bullet, change “students” to “student”, 4th bullet, 2nd line, replace “as well as” with “and an”, 5th bullet, add a slash between family/ student

No revisions to the policy at this time

Discussion on access fees versus consumables, lowering athletic participation fee (\$40/sport, \$160 family maximum), keep fees for co-curriculars groups if you are charging for athletic fees, many choir, tech ed and art fees are comparable to a school supply list for students. Keep band fees as is. No longer charge fees for Chromebook cases and insurance. Give parents an option to purchase the insurance or pay full cost if it gets broke. Provide a one-time Chromebook cover and if it gets lost, student has to purchase a new one through the school. No charge for PE uniforms, purchase one additional uniform through high school career.

Required credits include 4 English, 3 Social Studies, 3 Science, 3 Math and 1 ½ PE
