Medford Area Public School District Board of Education will adopt policies to guide the actions of those to whom it delegates authority. These policies will be recorded in writing and organized according to a standard policy classification system.

In formulating policies, the board of education will adopt general principles and statements of intent. The district administrator will, when necessary or when directed by the board of education, prepare written regulations to ensure the implementation of board of education policy.

The district administrator or his/her designee, in cooperation with staff and the board of education, will recommend policies for adoption and recommend revision of existing policies. Policies and/or revisions may be proposed by any member of the board of education, by any lay group or organization, or by any citizen. Recommended policies will not be formally acted on by the board of education until the regular meeting following the presentation of such policy to allow time for review and possible change.

The board of education will reappraise its policies periodically in view of the changing needs of the community and schools and delete outdated policies in the same manner as adoption procedures.
