A specific policy may be suspended during an emergency situation by the district administrator or their designee and board of education president. Such emergency situations must have a legitimate impact on the immediate health and safety of students and/or staff, or must interfere with the ability of the district to implement necessary fiscal transactions if the policy is not immediately suspended.

To suspend an existing board of education policy currently listed in the board of education policy book, the district administrator or their designee shall relate the facts regarding the “emergency situation” to the board of education president or in their absence, the next ranking officer in the order of vice president, clerk and treasurer. The district administrator or their designee shall identify the policy and define the course of action that is to be taken during the time of policy suspension as well as the length of policy suspension. The district administrator or their designee may suspend the policy in accordance with the actions described above only with the consent of the board of education president/officer. A suspended policy will automatically be reinstated if no regular or special action on that policy is taken at the next board of education meeting.
