Medford Area Public Schools shall provide school supervised community field work experience and transitional type opportunities for students where appropriate and/or required by law. All work experience will be coordinated by licensed school personnel and credit toward graduation may be given with the approval of the principal. It shall be designed to enable the learner to acquire attitudes, skills, and knowledge for work and other life roles by participating in or observing actual or simulated work settings. The specific operational procedure for each work experience and transitional type program shall be established by the building principal and the director of curriculum and instruction.
