In determining class rank, honor rolls, and other rankings where a Grade Point System is necessary; Medford Area Senior High School shall use the following:

A	=	4.00
A-	=	3.67
B+	=	3.33
B	=	3.00
B-	=	2.67
C+	=	2.33
C	=	2.00
C-	=	1.67
D+	=	1.33
D	=	1.00
D-	=	.67
E	=	.33
F	=	.00

Under this system no "A+," "F+," or "F-" will be recorded as a report card grade. The "E" (*effort grade*) will still be available for teachers to use where they feel it is appropriate. The "E" will carry .33 grade point value.

Adjustments will be made in point values where weighted grading applies as provided in the "Student Handbook."
