As required by law, Medford Area Public Schools will be open, free and without charge for tuition to all persons between the ages of 4 and 21 residing within the attendance area established for that school. Residents of the district under age 4 and over 20 years of age may be admitted under applicable state and federal statutes.

Applications from nonresident students will be considered in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes. Nonresident students may apply for tuition waivers. Such waivers may be granted to the extent allowed or required by state statute.

All requirements regarding age, health examinations, student achievement, immunizations and other admission requirements which apply to resident students will also apply to nonresident students who enroll in Medford Area Public Schools.

The Medford Area Public School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientations, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or homelessness status. This policy does not, however, prohibit the district from placing a student in a school, class, program or activity based on objective standards of individual performance or need. Discrimination complaints shall be handled in accordance with established procedures. The district encourages informal resolution of complaints under this policy. A formal complaint resolution procedure is available, however, to address allegations of violations of the policy in the Medford Area Public School District.
