K through 12th grade students who are residents of the Medford Area Public School District and who are currently attending a private school, home-based private educational program or open enrolled to another school district shall be allowed to enroll in the Medford Area Public Schools for up to two regular school day courses under the following conditions:

1. The student has met all standards for admission established by the Medford Area Public School District.
2. The student has satisfied any prerequisites and/or entrance requirements for the course(s) he/she wishes to take.
3. The student must reside in the Medford Area Public School District.
4. Sufficient space is available in the classroom(s) as determined by the Medford Area Public School District.
5. The student must submit a written application at least six weeks prior to the starting date of the course(s). Applications are to be submitted to the school principal who will determine the student's eligibility for participation in the course(s).
6. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s); however, dual enrollment students may ride Medford Area Public School District buses if schedules and routes coincide with the student's schedule. Bus routes and schedules will not be changed to accommodate dual enrollment students.
7. Must meet WIAA requirements in order to participate in athletics.
