The Medford Area Public School District Board of Education sanctions and recommends the organization of a Student Council in the high school and the middle school. Such councils shall assist in improving the general welfare of all students and shall give students the opportunity to participate in the orderly workings of the democratic process.

The Student Councils shall not have authority to make policies for the district or regulations for the school, nor shall they have disciplinary authority except with respect to Student Council members as prescribed in the Student Council Constitution. Councils may make recommendations to the administration on any topic of student concern.

Members of the Student Councils shall be selected by staff after an application/interview process. The rights and responsibilities of the Council shall be clearly set forth in a constitution. Advisor(s) for each Student Council shall be selected by the building principal.
