The Medford Area Public School District is committed to maintaining a secure environment and productive academic atmosphere. Every member of the school community is expected to cooperate in this mission. Behavior that is dangerous, disruptive, damaging to property, interferes with or threatens to interfere with the normal routines of the educational process of the school will not be tolerated.

It is imperative that students, as part of the overall school community, are involved in the process of prevention and/or identification of dangerous, disruptive, damaging or threatening acts of behavior. The district encourages students and staff to report to administration observations, concerns or other information regarding dangerous, disruptive, damaging or threatening behavior.

The district may solicit information from students in situations where the behavior or actions of others have led to school cancellation, evacuation or delayed start, endangered or caused physical or emotional harm to another individual, resulted in damage to property or have been referred to law enforcement for investigation. Furthermore, the district may determine to provide a monetary or other tangible incentive when such information leads to the prevention of dangerous, disruptive, damaging acts or the identification and apprehension of the perpetrator(s).
