State statute requires that all students through grade 12 and children attending day care centers must meet minimum immunization requirements. These requirements can be waived only for reasons of health, religious, or personal conviction.

The Medford Area Public School District nurse shall, using the legal forms provided by the Department of Health Services, implement the steps of the "School Immunization Compliance Time Line" as prescribed in state statute and the administrative procedures of the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services.

It is the policy of the Medford Area Public School District that:

- The School District Nurse shall be responsible for supervision of maintenance and monitoring immunization records throughout the district to ensure compliance as prescribed by state law.
- Upon admission to the district each student will have in his/her health file and immunization record as required by law. These immunization forms can be obtained from each school office.
- Pursuant to state and federal laws, that no person, on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability may be denied admission to any school in this district or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be discriminated against in any co-curricular, student services or other program.
