

Anne M. Fleegel Memorial Scholarship

Anne Fleegel was a leader in the Medford community and committed to supporting students and families in the Medford Area School District. Anne shared her values of patience, commitment, selflessness, and compassion with everyone around her. This scholarship is provided as a memorial to her life and support for students who share these values with a commitment to serving others.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be a graduating senior or recent graduate of Medford Area Senior High School pursuing a degree in Special Education or related field. Previous recipients of this scholarship are invited to submit a new application; see alternate essay questions in the application.

One or more \$500 scholarships will be awarded. The number of scholarships will be determined based on the number of eligible applicants.

How to Apply:

1. Make a copy of this document and complete the application form.
2. The full application should include:
 - Completed Application form
 - Essay
 - Unofficial transcript, and
 - Copy of a letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend (not needed if you are currently enrolled and have submitted a copy of your unofficial transcript)

4. The scholarship funds will be paid on or around January 19, 2027, after the recipient has provided evidence of successful completion of the first semester.
