As a detective, Jason was part of the County's Special Investigations Unit and, at the time of his death, was serving as a general detective. Throughout his career, Jason was deeply committed to his community and passionate about creating a safe environment for families. More than anything, Jason loved being a police officer. He took great pride in mentoring others and was always eager to help fellow officers find answers, even when he didn't have them himself.
