

## Medford Area Community Theatre (MACT) Scholarship

The MACT Scholarship was established to recognize the contributions of young thespians and technicians who have shared their numerous talents with the Medford area community throughout their high school careers and who plan to promote and participate in community performing arts activities after graduation.

### Scholarship Award Information

1. Annually, one or more candidates **may** receive a scholarship.
2. The amount awarded to any one recipient will not exceed \$1000.00.
3. Any scholarship awarded is at the sole discretion of the MACT Board of Directors.
4. Scholarship(s) will be awarded at the end of semester upon proof of successful completion and continued enrollment in post-secondary coursework.
5. Scholarships are not renewable.
6. Scholarship winner(s) will be notified by letter. Any scholarship awarded will be presented at the awards assembly at the candidate's high school and/or at the opening of the MACT summer production.

### Eligibility Requirements

1. Candidate must be a graduating senior at an accredited high school.
2. Candidate must be accepted to and planning to enroll full-time in an accredited institution of post-secondary education.
3. Candidate must have participated in at least one Medford Area Community Theatre production. **Participation includes both on-stage and off-stage activities.**

### Application Requirements

1. A completed application form.
2. A completed list of performing arts experience and training.
3. A 1-2 page essay, typed, double-spaced, in 12 pt. font, using standard written English that discusses why you are the best candidate for the MACT scholarship and how you intend to stay involved in the performing arts.
4. Personal interviews may be requested by the MACT Board of Directors.
5. The completed application and all other required materials must be post marked no later than April 1. All incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.

### Selection Criteria

1. Application and all other required materials are post marked no later than April 1.
2. Candidate meets all eligibility requirements.
3. Breadth of candidate's participation in MACT, high school, and/or other community performing arts productions/events/activities.  
Participation includes both on-stage and off-stage activities.
4. Responses on the application form.
5. Quality of the essay.
6. Quality of responses in personal interview, if interview is requested.
7. The Board of Directors may contact adults whom have worked with the candidate for their evaluation of the candidate's attitude and quality of work/performance.
