



### Medford Morning Rotary Club Scholarship

- I. The non-renewable scholarship determined by the Rotary is to be used at a university or technical college. The scholarship money will be sent to MASH in your name after you successfully complete one semester and submit the required grade point documentation and registration for another semester.
  
- II. Criteria:
  - a) At least a 3.0 GPA
  - b) Two years of participation in a school-related or community-based volunteer organization while in high school.
  - c) Positive role modeling to other students - having led by example.
  - d) Completed application and returned by the established deadline of April 15th.
  - e) Interview at a Rotary meeting (chosen from applications submitted by our Rotary Scholarship Committee).
  
- III. In the event that there are more than two viable candidates for the scholarship, you will be notified no later than May 1st if you are chosen to be interviewed at the next Rotary Meeting following May 1st. We meet the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays each month at 6:45 am at Marilyn's.
